
### **Titanic Morse Code**

Morse code is a way to transmit messages without words. An alphabet is made from short or long flashes of light or sounds.



John Phillips and Harold Bride, the Marconi operators on Titanic, received and transmitted messages using Morse code. A Marconi was a wireless machine for sending messages. These messages included communications with other ships and messages sent from passengers to friends and family on land. Morse code was also used by Phillips and Bride to send distress signals on the night of the Titanic disaster.

#### Did You Know...?

Arthur Moore was a Welsh amateur radio operator. He heard the distress signals sent by Phillips and Bride through Morse code on the night of the disaster from thousands of miles away. He rushed to his local police station to let the police know but they were unwilling to believe him. Arthur Moore was proved right a couple of days later when newspapers started reporting on the sinking of the Titanic. As a result, Moore went on to have a successful career with Marconi.







Can your partner record your Morse code and decode your message?				




